## **POLICY WITH RESPECT TO CONSERVATION, ACCESS AND RECREATION**

Dee Valley Water (“the Company”) recognises its responsibilities under the 1989 Water Act (Sections 8 and 9) with respect to conservation, access and recreation.

The Company will seek to ensure that its activities in water supply will involve consideration for the conservation and enhancement, wherever possible, of its land holdings.

The Company will have regard to the protection and maintenance of any sites and objects of special natural interest or of archaeological, architectural or historic importance.

Where possible, the Company will permit public access to its land and holdings taking into account the need for safeguarding the quality of water supplied to its customers.

Facilities for suitable recreational activity for individual members of the public or for organised groups are available within the Company's holdings.

Dee Valley Water will consult or seek advice from relevant interested parties whenever a project or development has environmental relevance.
